Crossing Guards**

School Crossing Guards are responsible for safely crossing our children at intersections near schools in the City of Owen Sound. Our Crossing Guards are reliable and responsible men and women who interact well with children and are committed to their safety.

Casual Part-time Crossing Guards are required in the event a Regular Crossing Guard is not available in the morning before school, during lunch hour and after school, for the duration of the school year.

Successful applicants must pass a background investigation prior to employment, and must be capable of standing for 45 minutes to an hour at a time *in all weather conditions*. Crossing Guards must be 18 years of age or older and provide their own transportation to and from the post.

No experience is necessary, all training is provided. Crossing Guards must be pleasant, courteous and helpful towards all members of the public at all times. All equipment such as safety vests and stop signs are provided by the City of Owen Sound.
