(Owen Sound, ON) It was a great day for the new Regional Recreation Centre as two cheques totaling \$50,000 were presented to campaign co-chair Sonya Mount.

The first \$25,000 donation was presented by Michael Todd, General Manager of Stone Tree Golf and Fitness Club. "We are proud to support the new recreation centre. It will change the landscape of this community," said Todd. "It makes a lot of sense for us to be involved as I think of the Y as a partner in providing health and fitness opportunities to everyone."

The second donation was from the Coulter family. The entire family, Frank and Sharon, Pam and Ted, and Zachary and Hayden, handed over their \$25,000 donation. Speaking on behalf of the family, Pam Coulter commented, "It is our pleasure to contribute to this project. We are a family committed to the rec centre and it will be great for the community."

In recognition of their generous contributions, both Stone Tree and the Coulter family will each have an arena dressing room named in their honour in the new recreation centre.

Commenting on these two major gifts that have helped propel the campaign to reach 34 per cent of the \$5,000,000 campaign goal, Sonya Mount commented, "There is widespread support for the rec centre and it is so important to have families and corporations involved. These are very generous gifts and we thank you for stepping up with your financial support."

Construction is underway on the \$38.6 million, 125,000 sq. ft. regional recreation centre. It will house two NHL-sized ice rinks, a health and fitness centre, a walking/running track and two pools, one competitive-sized and one for leisure and therapy.
